






Emergency Calls 2020 - 2022





February Call Type and Station Breakdown





Station Breakdown





- February had an increase in Cardiac Arrest calls

- Increase in Motor Vehicle accidents over the last two months (13)

Significant calls

- Tubac Fire Responded to the Sunflower RV park for reports of a structure fire. The fire was in the laundry room and was quickly extinguished by fire crews.
- Tubac Fire Responded to a mutual aid structure fire at the City of Nogales involving a commercial building.
- Tubac Fire units responded to a rollover involving a truck that rolled ejecting both passengers.




Training

In service Equipment


- ♦ Unit 1058 has been placed in service at station #2


