

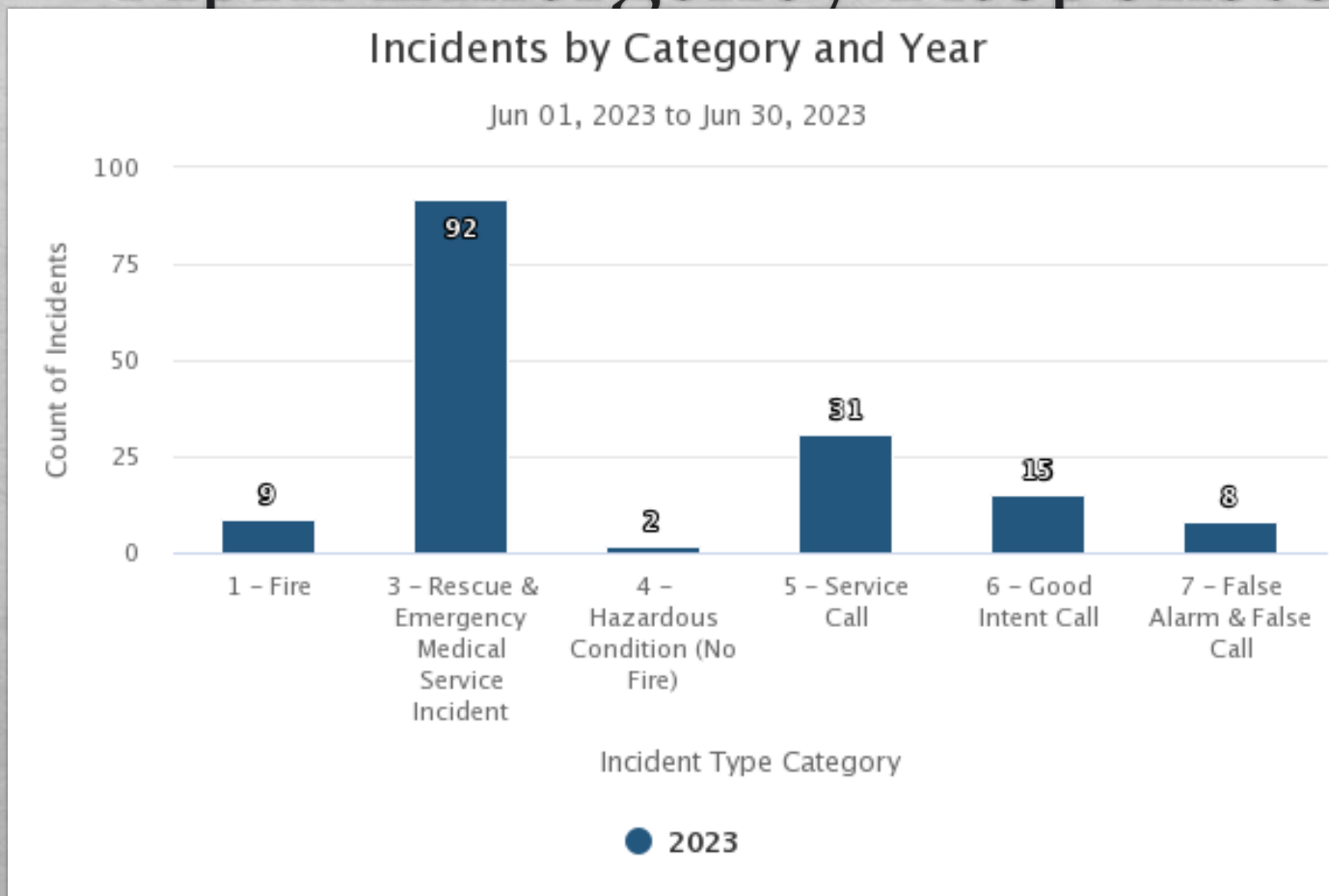

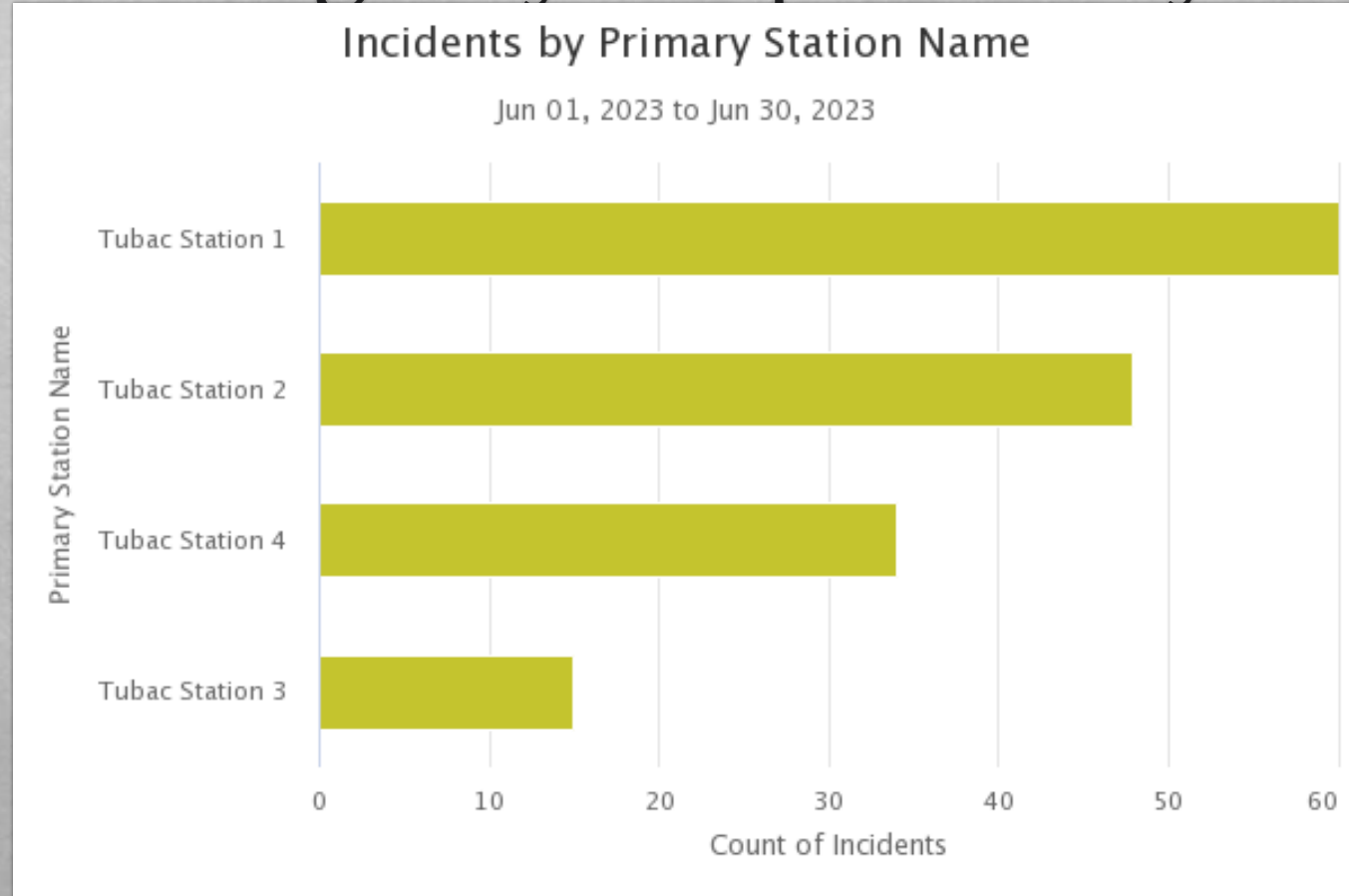


April Emergency Responses

April Emergency Responses By Station

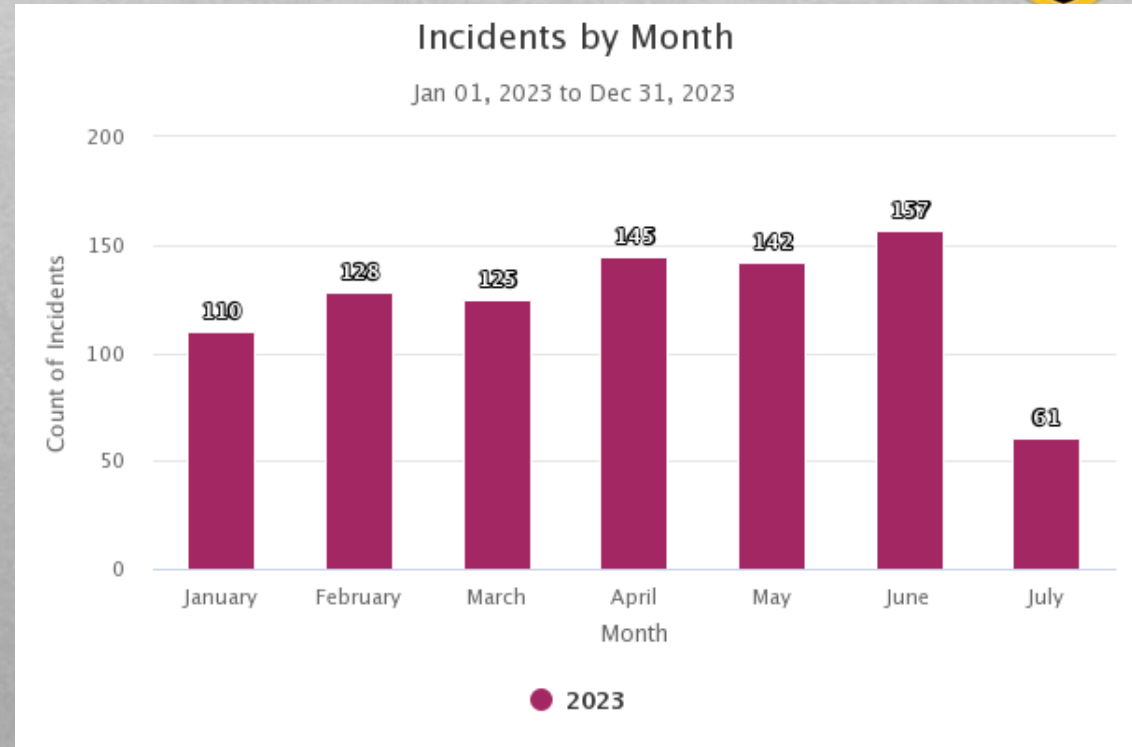

Significant Calls



- C Shift crew responded to Hwy 83 MP 15 in reference to a vehicle rollover with 6 occupants who were ejected. M-734 arrived on scene and assisted in packaging a patient for a helicopter flight to a Tucson hospital. In all, 4 patients were flown via helicopters and 2 were transported via ground ambulance.

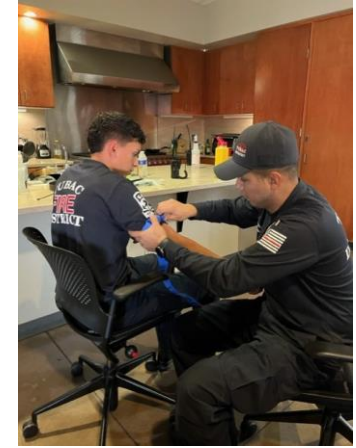
- B Shift crew responded on Wednesday night for a structure fire, on arrival they found a manufactured home and an RV fully involved.

- A shift responded for a 9 yr old boy who was having seizure activity. With only coordinates to go by as a location, we were able to hike out and locate the patient who was still in a postictal state along with two other individuals he was traveling with. With help of border patrol and one of their ATV units we were able to get the boy to the ambulance much faster and on their way to the hospital. CEP Marchbanks later reported that the boys' condition had improved before he left the hospital.

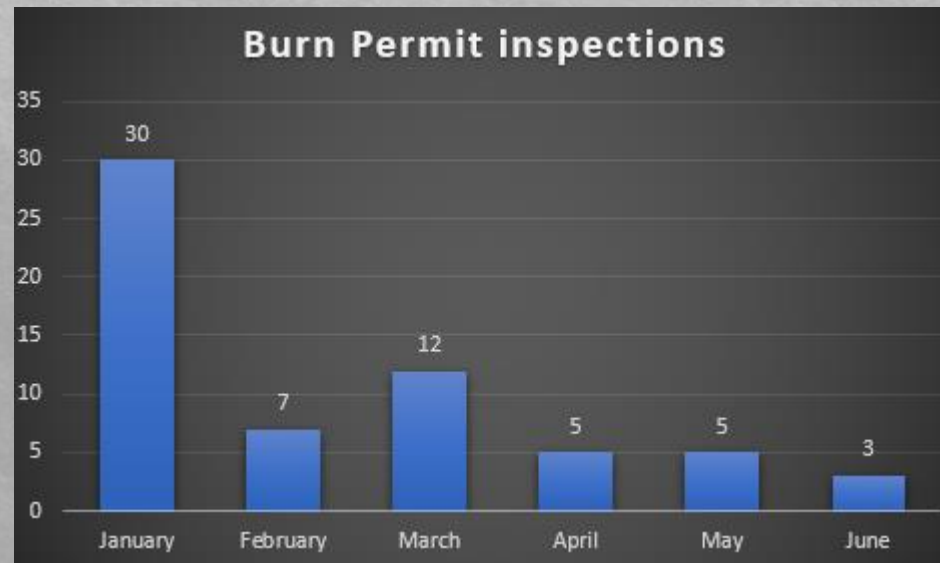
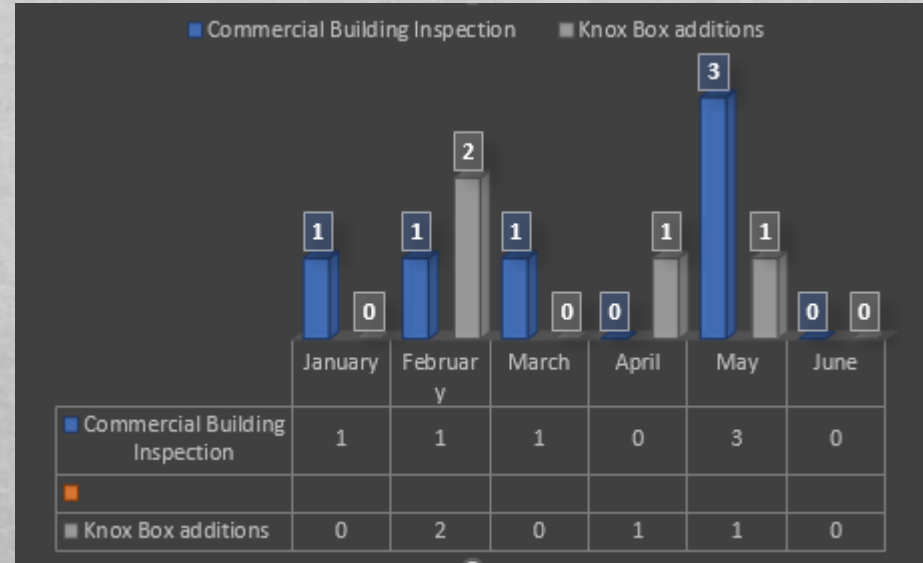
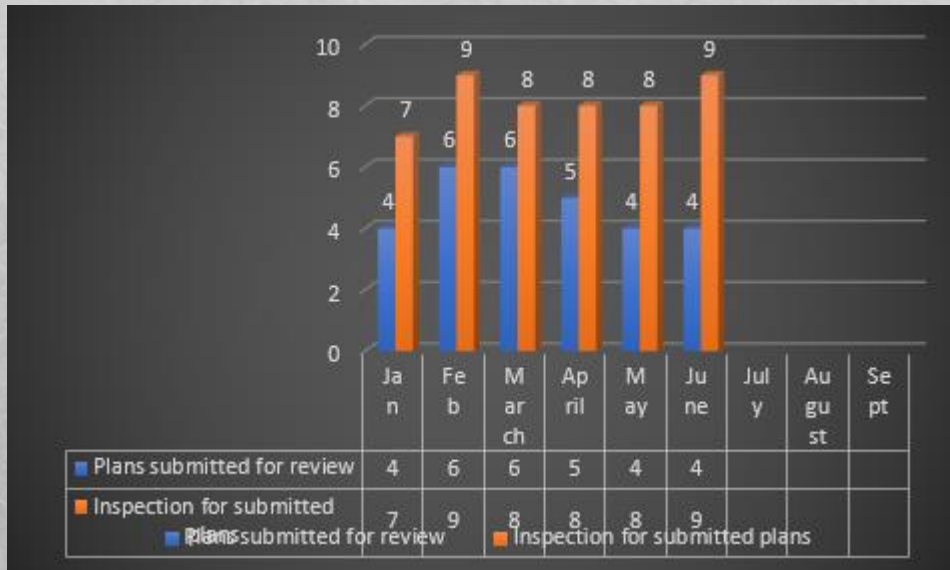
